

# **Security Spotlight**

Officer Willie Long - From Pharmacist to Physical Security Professional



One thing I have learned in this business is that all of us have a varied and interesting journey into the profession. Officer Willie Long is no exception, though he is exceptional! My team was lucky to welcome Officer Long to our campus in May 2024, where he trained alongside our tenured officer team, quickly learned our processes and embraced every post. He was at once identified as the breath of fresh air needed at our main reception position - that perfect combination of the security mindset and customer service. I've enjoyed getting to know Willie and hope you all do too:

My name is Willie, and I grew up in Plant City, Florida found 20 miles east of Tampa. I've been married for forty-three years to my wife, with whom I share two adult daughters. I started my pharmacy career in 1980 after graduating from Florida A&M University School of Pharmacy. My first job was with Eckerd Drugs. I spent eighteen years with Eckerd before joining The Winn-Dixie Pharmacy team in 1998. After spending another eighteen years with Winn-Dixie I was affected by company downsizing at the age of 60. I had spent 36 years practicing pharmacy and now was without a job for the first time. At the time, I believed I would be with another company within weeks. After the weeks turned into six months, I started looking for work outside of pharmacy.

The first career that came to mind was teaching because it was something I had secretly always wanted to do. I became a substitute teacher and started working toward a teacher certification. I received a temporary certification in science and was on the verge of being hired by the Duval County School Board when I started having doubts about teaching. Although I loved the idea of teaching, I finally realized that it wasn't for me. The kids were more than I could handle!

Now over the age of 60, and with a mortgage that was being paid with funds drawn from my retirement account, I needed a new plan. I filed for early retirement and started looking for a new role that complemented my skill set.

A friend suggested I become a security officer, so I enrolled in a class to get my D-license. After completing the class, I started my first job in physical security with Allied Universal Security (AUS). I spent five years with AUS before starting my present job with First Coast Security (FCS).

Physical security is full of opportunities. There are shifts and posts to meet whatever you are looking for. I am amazed at how many communities, institutions, neighborhoods, factories, and facilities need physical security professionals. Physical Security is everywhere and there are jobs to meet every skill level. So, if you are looking for something to do after retirement give physical security a shot! It's working for me!

Officer Stacey Farrell – Allied Universal

Officer Farrell received permission to intercept the person in the river and render assistance. Officer Farrell was able to reach the person in the river and pull them safely into the boat. Officer Farrell transported the Individual to the pier where he met with Allied Universal personnel and emergency responders. The person pulled from the river was subsequently evaluated for injuries by medical personnel.
