Legislative Update



1. Enhanced Cybersecurity Measures

In response to growing cyber threats, several legislative measures have been introduced to bolster cybersecurity protocols. The National Security Memorandum on Critical Infrastructure Security and Resilience outlines new requirements for sector-specific risk management plans, which are to be updated biennially. This includes comprehensive risk assessments and proposals for new legislative authorities to enforce minimum security standards for critical infrastructure

(The White House).

2. Advancements in Physical Security Technologies

Recent reports highlight significant trends in physical security technologies, such as the increased adoption of cloud-based surveillance solutions and AI-driven analytics. These technologies aim to streamline security operations and enhance the detection and response capabilities of organizations. Legislative bodies are now focusing on ensuring these technologies comply with data protection regulations and are securely integrated into existing infrastructure (<u>Avigilon</u>) (<u>Security World</u>).

3. Focus on Data Protection and Privacy

Legislation around data protection continues to tighten, with new regulations emphasizing the importance of encryption, ransomware detection, and IT security analytics. These measures are designed to protect both physical and digital assets, addressing vulnerabilities that could lead to significant financial and reputational damage. Compliance with these regulations is critical for businesses to avoid hefty

4. Sector-Specific Security Enhancements

Legislative efforts are also targeting specific sectors, requiring tailored security measures to address unique vulnerabilities. For example, new laws mandate comprehensive security protocols for healthcare facilities, emphasizing the protection of patient data and critical health infrastructure. Similarly, financial institutions are facing stricter regulations to safeguard against cyber-attacks and physical breaches (<u>Genetec</u>).

5. International Collaboration and Standards

There is a notable push towards international collaboration in setting security standards. Legislators are working with global bodies to harmonize security protocols, ensuring a unified approach to tackling cross-border security threats. This includes adopting best practices from leading security frameworks and integrating them into national legislation to enhance overall resilience (<u>The White House</u>).

Florida Legislature

Noteworthy Florida Bills:

CS/CS/CS/HB 275:

This bill addresses offenses involving critical infrastructure, enhancing penalties for those who impede, threaten, or harass first responders and critical infrastructure personnel.

CS/HB 305:

Focuses on the protection of children, implementing stricter measures for offenses involving minors.

CS/SB 678:

Establishes a grant program for forensic investigative genetic genealogy, aiding law enforcement in solving cold cases using advanced DNA technologies. CS/CS/SB 718:

Enhances protections for first responders against exposures to fentanyl and its analogs, improving safety measures and response protocols.

These legislative changes aim to strengthen physical security measures, protect critical infrastructure, and enhance the safety of first responders and vulnerable populations in Florida.


